PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Polycote Solvent Cleaner is an industrial grade solvent formulation based on a mixture of Xylenes.

TYPICAL USES

Solvent Cleaner is used to clean mixing and application tools following application of epoxy-based coatings and repair materials. It may be used as a release agent to trowel a smooth finish when applying *Polycote Cretex EP*. Solvent Cleaner is also suitable for cleaning acrylic and polyurethane based material off application tools provided it does not come into contact with the applied material.

COLOUR

Solvent Cleaner is a clear colourless liquid.

PACKAGING

Solvent Cleaner is supplied in 1.0 litre and 5.0 litre units.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATION

Always wear suitable gloves and work in accordance with Health & Safety advice given.

KEEP CONTAINER TIGHTLY CLOSED WHEN NOT IN USE as the Solvent will otherwise evaporate.

For use with Cretex EP – using a cloth, apply a coating of Solvent Cleaner to the trowel before applying *Cretex EP*. This will enable a smooth finish to be achieved with this characteristically sticky repair material. Repeat the coating regularly as the work progresses.

For use as a cleaning agent – apply liberally to mixing and application tools **WHILST RESIN IS STILL WET**. Wipe away the residues with a cloth. After use place cloths into a sealed container for disposal.

SHELF LIFE & STORAGE

Shelf Life is 12 months in unopened container subject to conditions of storage. Storage should be in accordance with the Highly Flammable Liquids and Petroleum Gases Regulations 1972.
